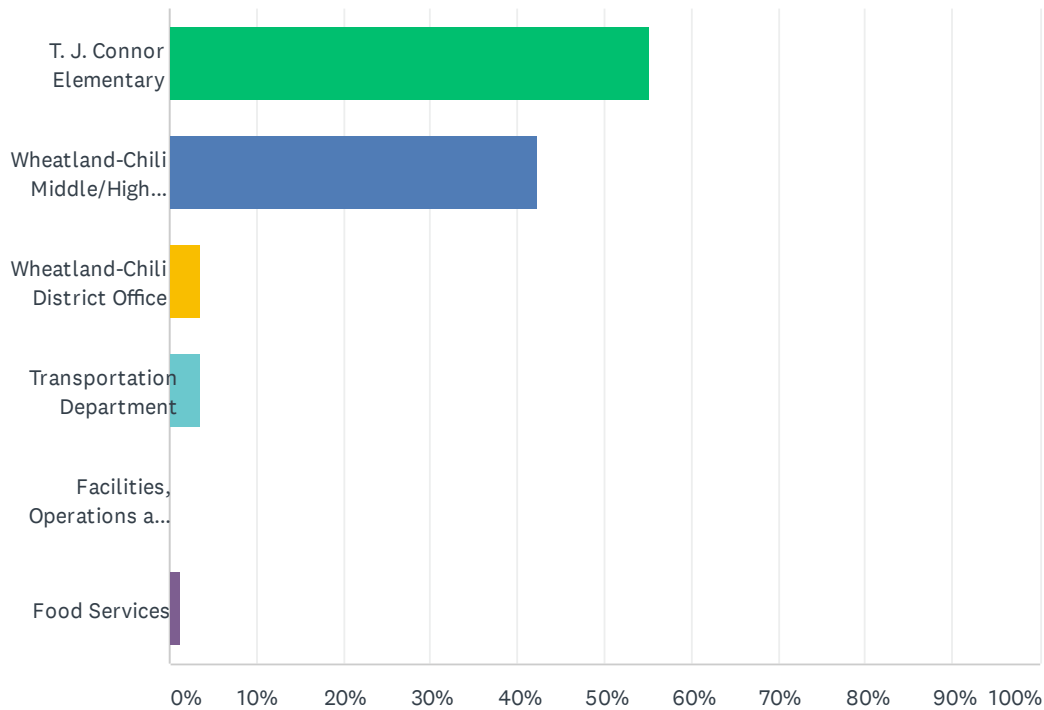


Q1 Which school or building/department do you work in? (Select all the apply)

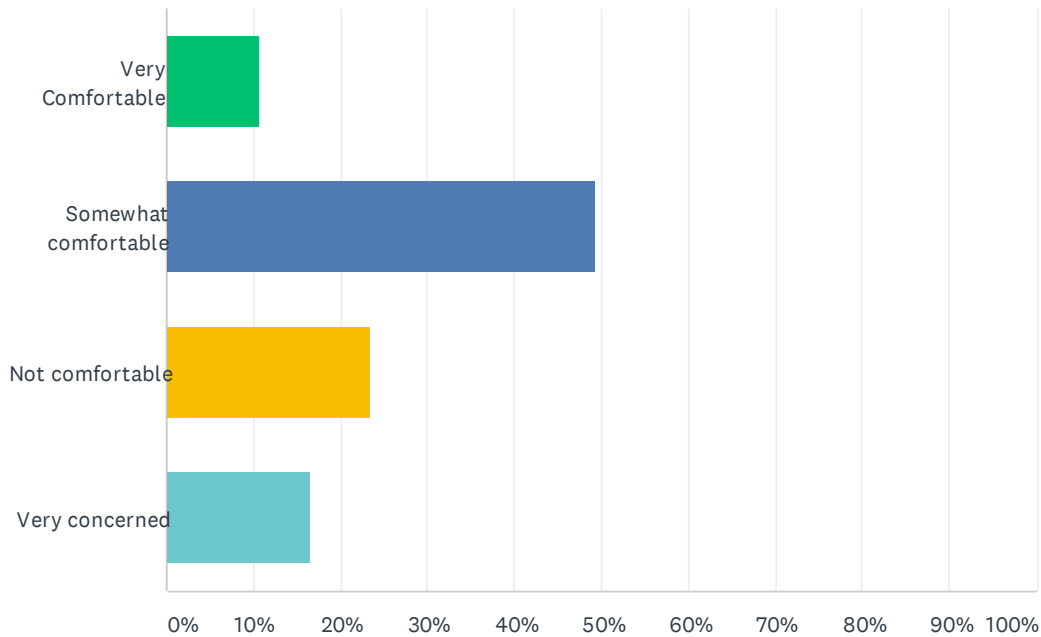

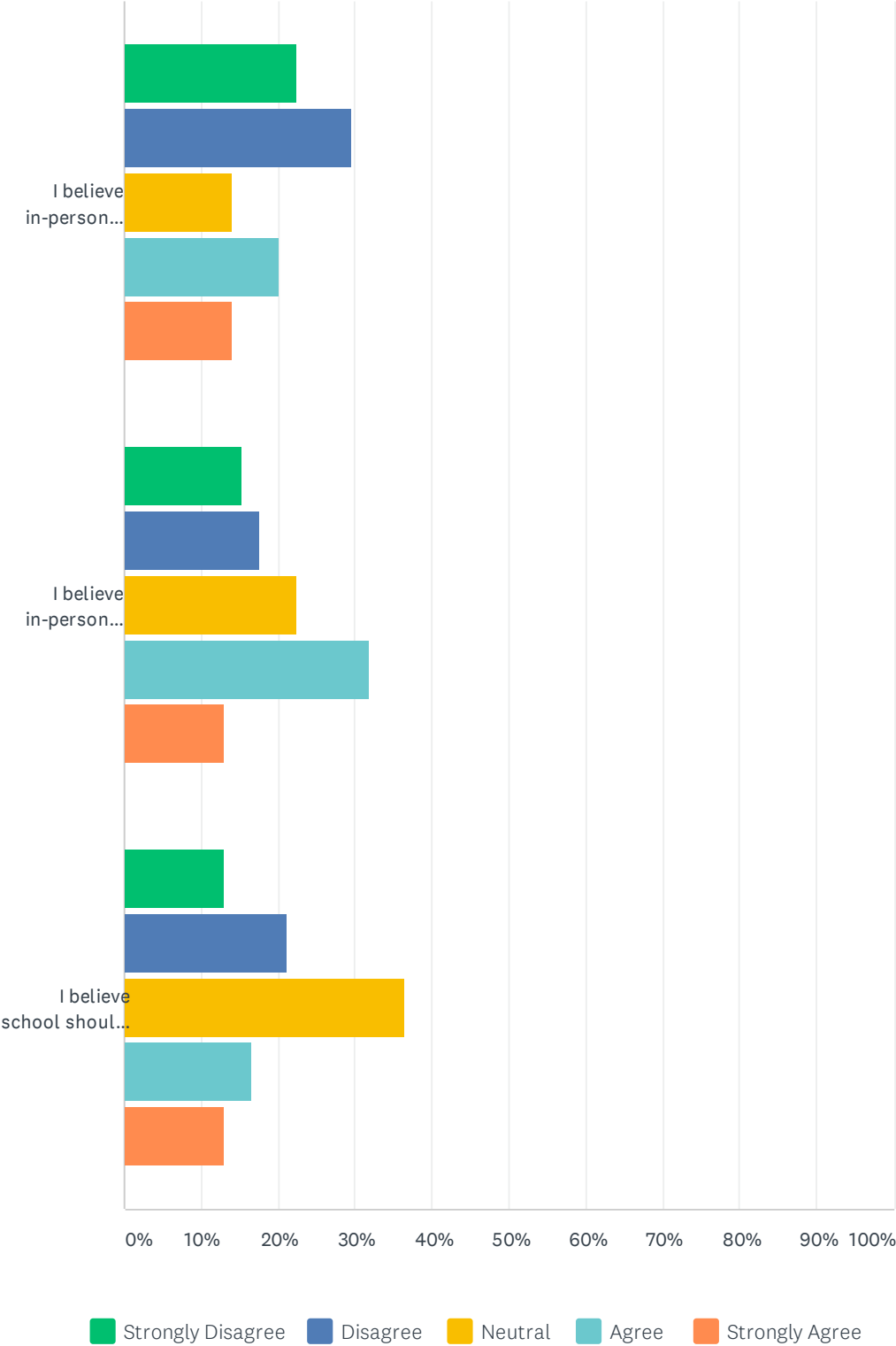

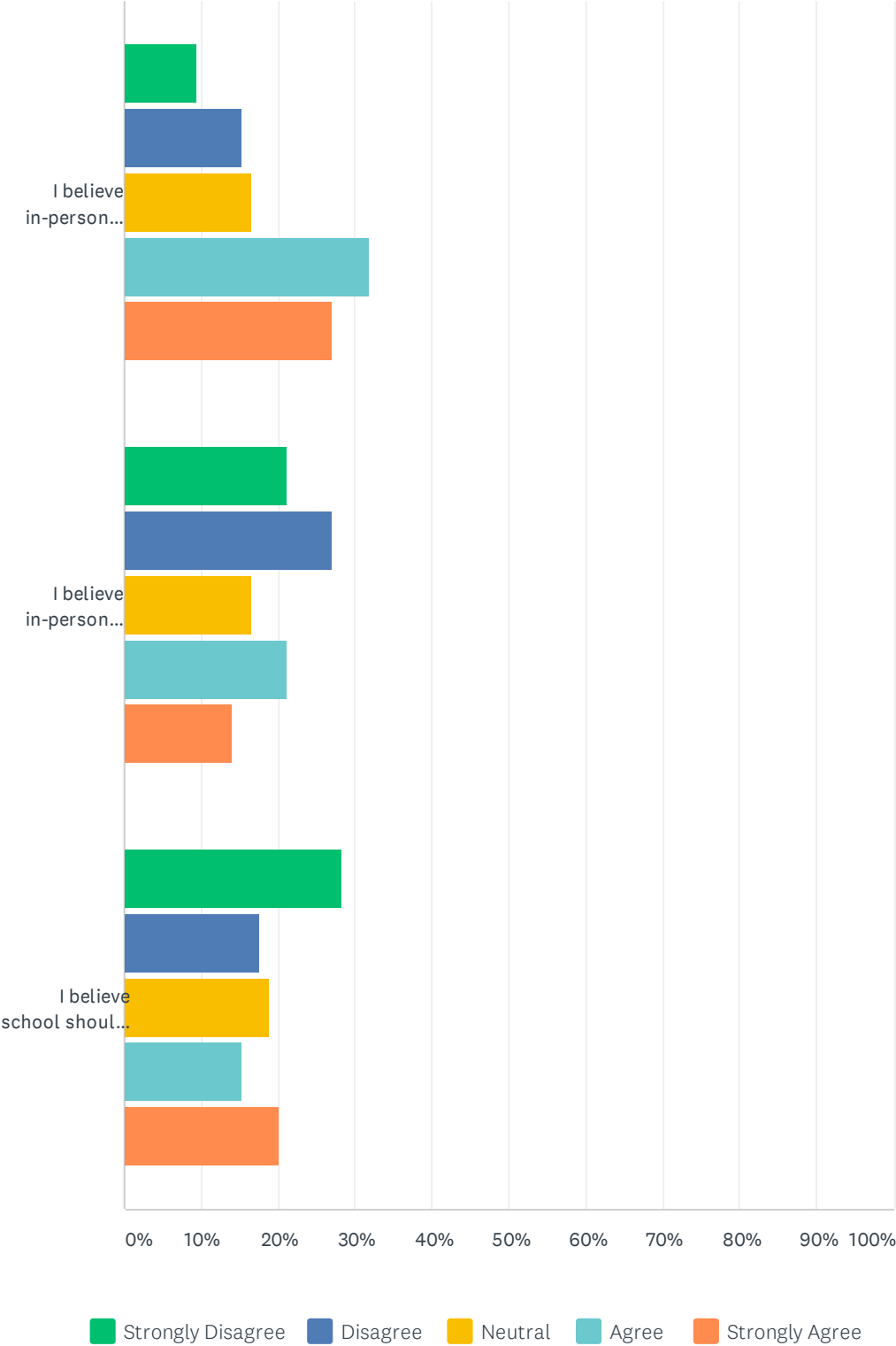

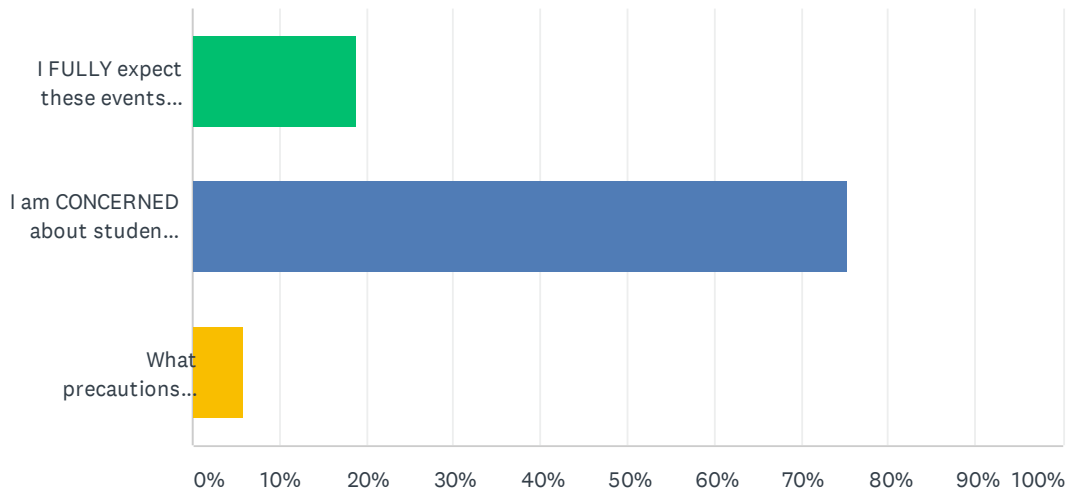

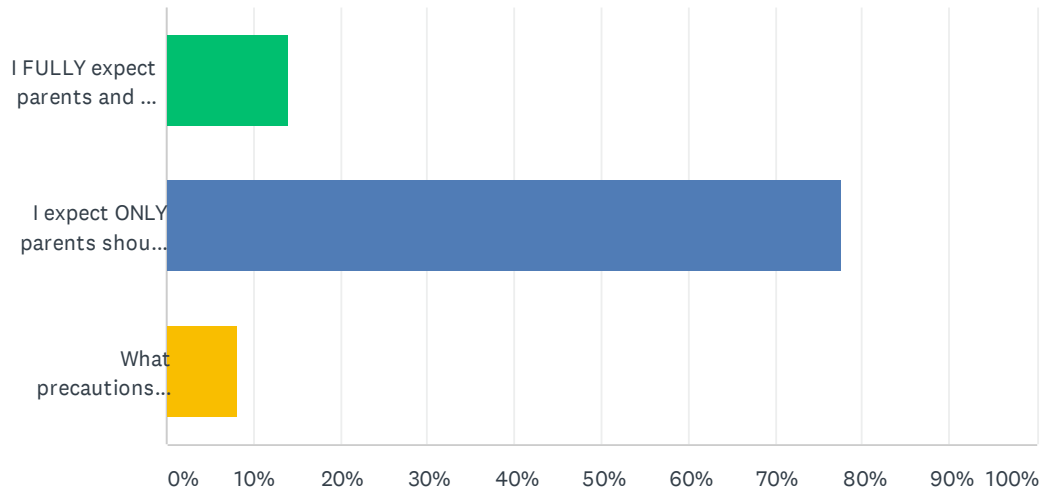

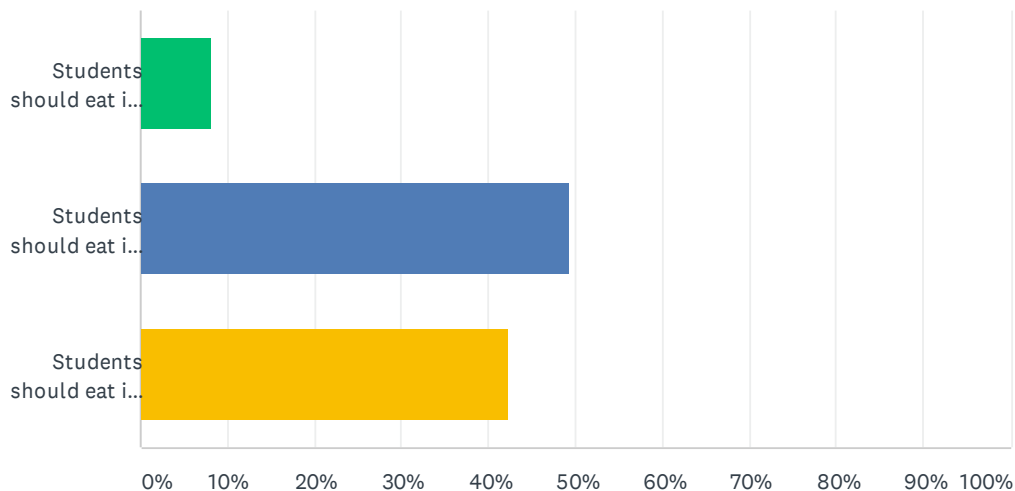

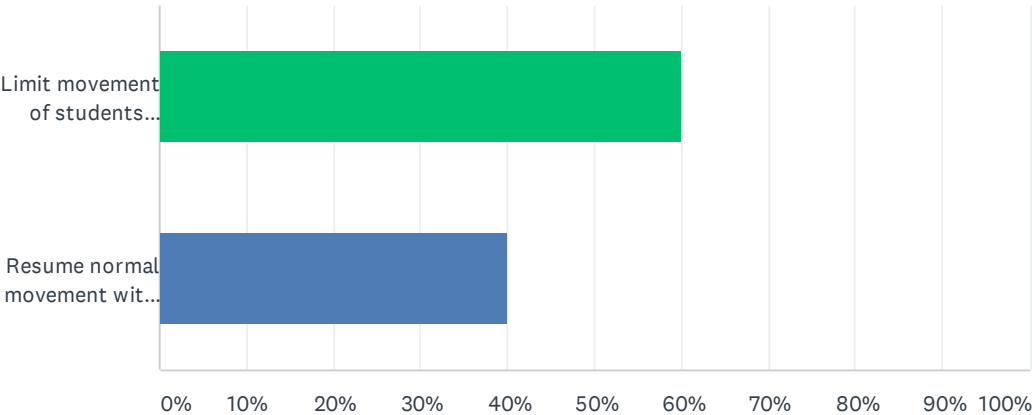

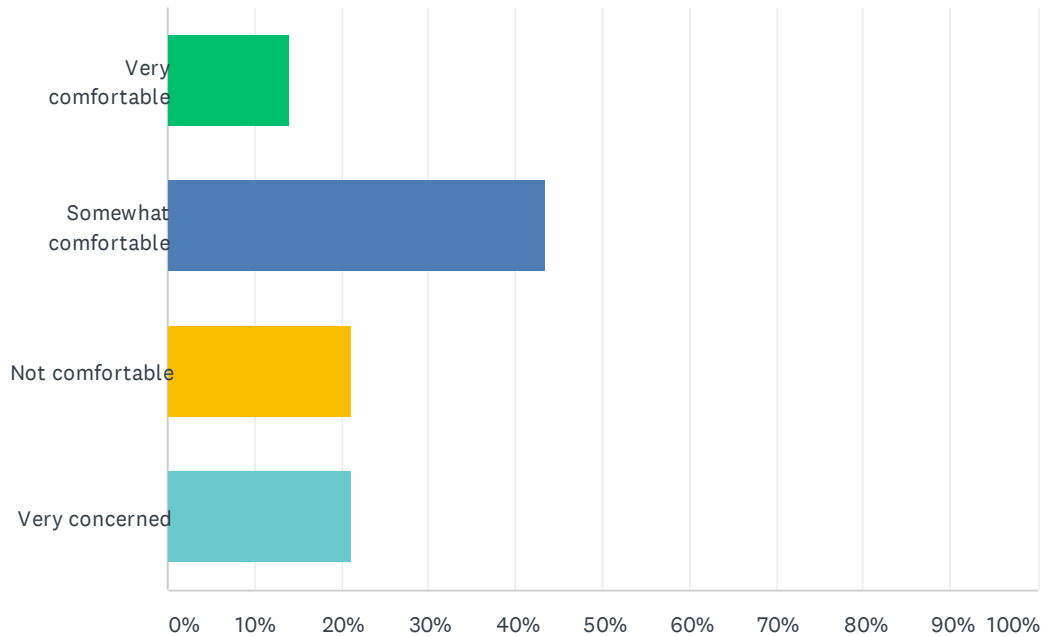

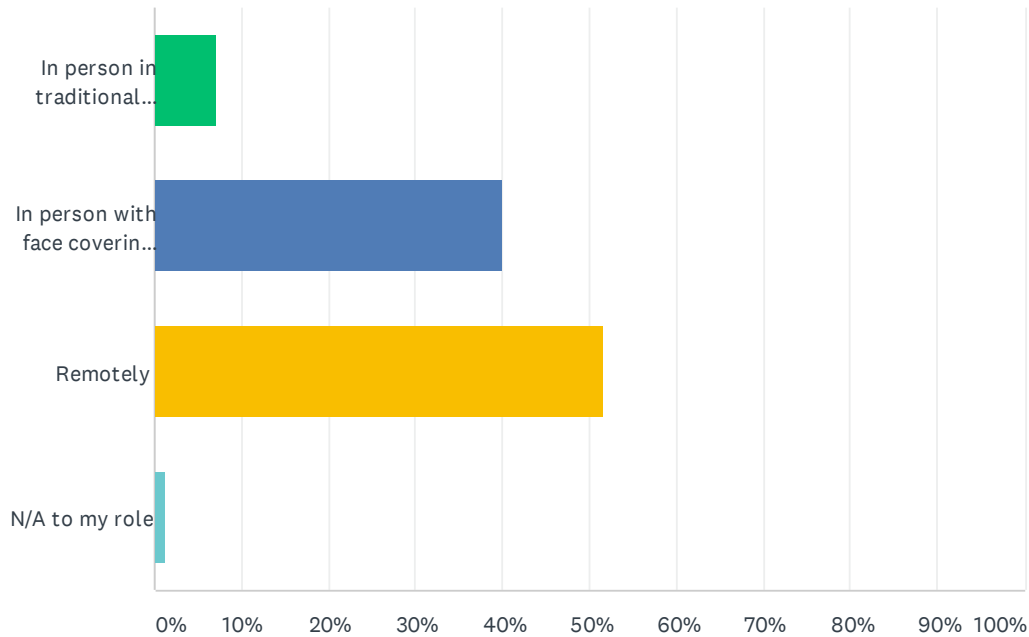

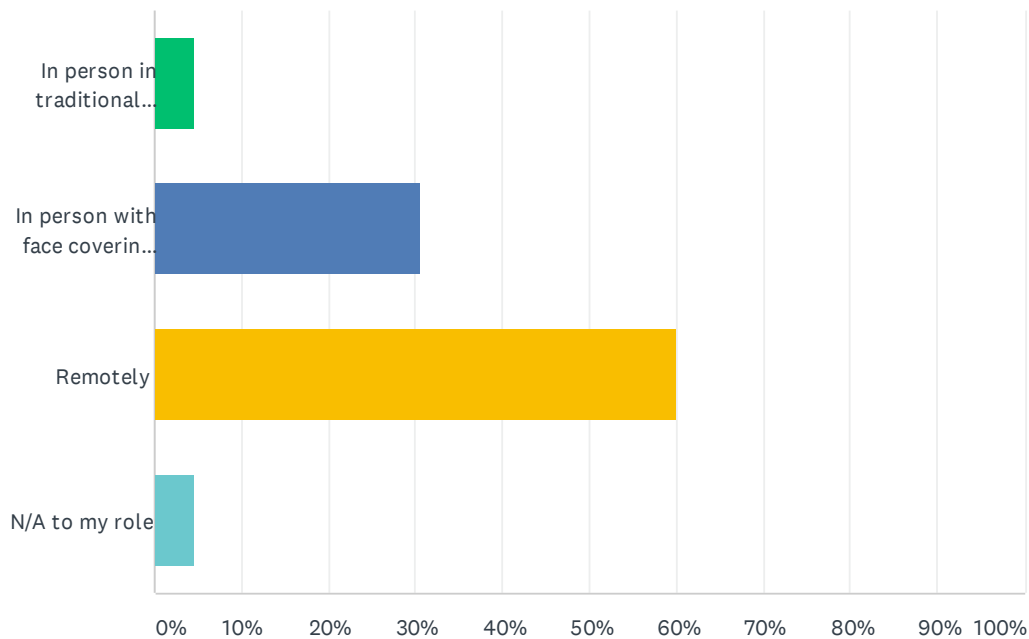

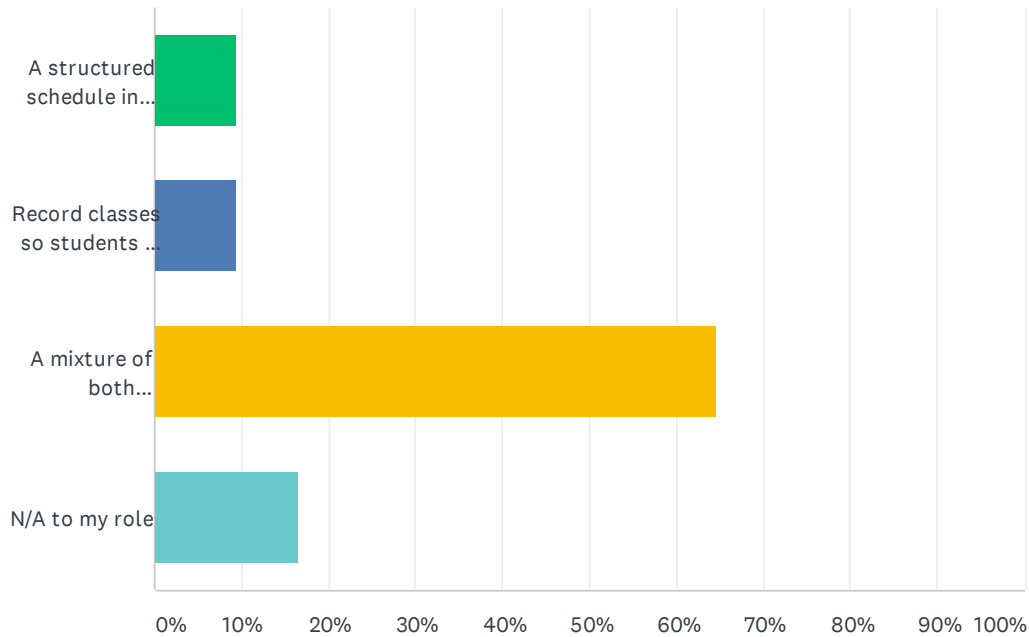

Q12 As the District continues to use remote learning, do you prefer

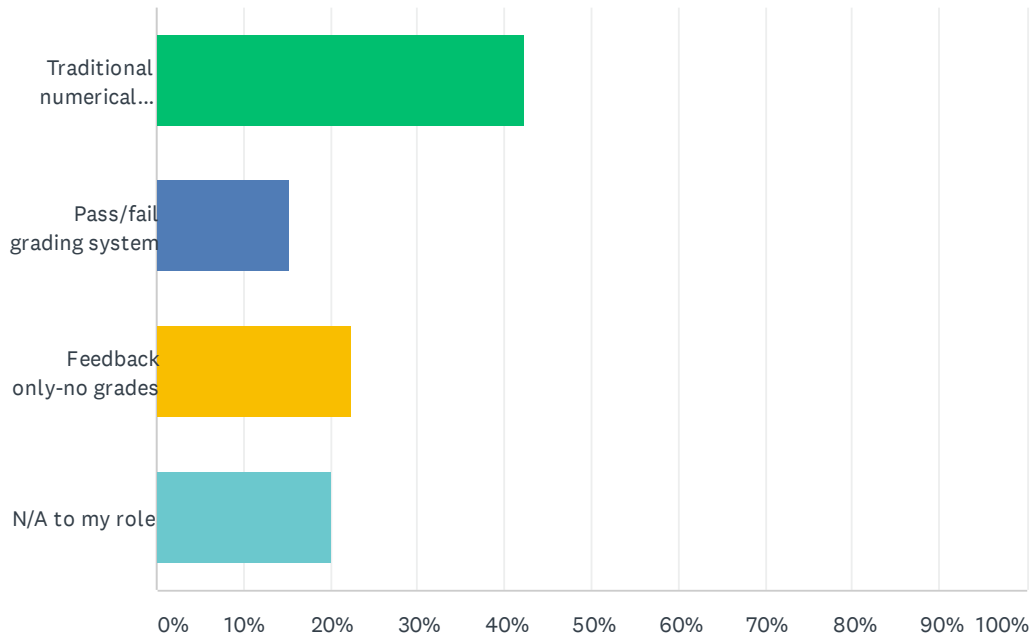

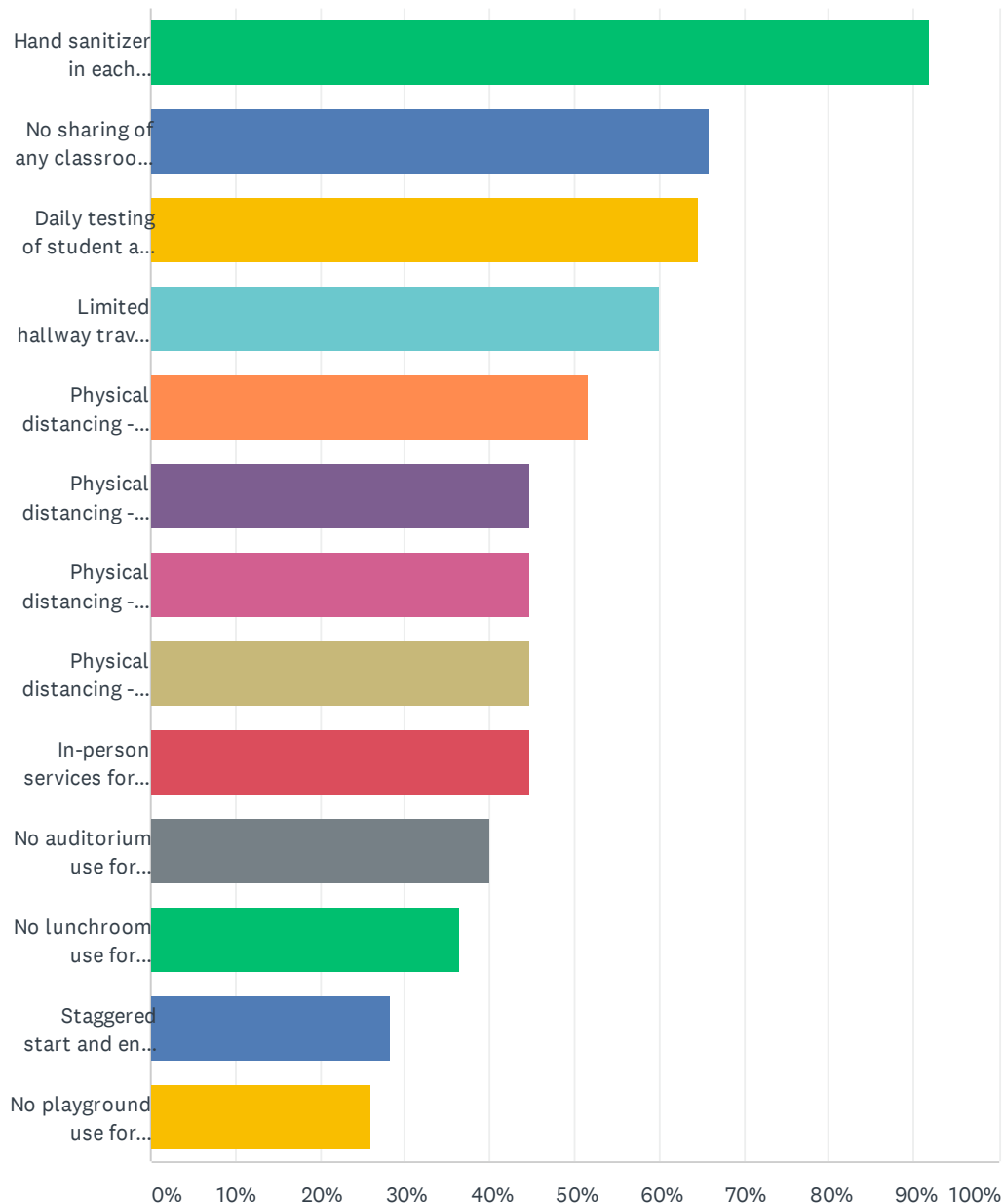
