2. Student must be a full-time 12th grade student.
3. Student must be graduating from high school in June.
4. Student must be committed to continuing his/her educational growth.

1. Fill out the application form.
2. Submit one letter of recommendation.
3. Submit an essay that describes the steps you have taken toward your future interests, how your post-secondary plans support these interests, and how this scholarship will support your continued growth. Please review the attached criteria sheet before beginning your essay.
