The Wheatland-Chili 8th grade class has traditionally celebrated the end of middle school with the "8th Grade Bash". The current 8th grade class would like to celebrate their 8th Grade Bash with a trip to Darien Lake.

For the 2016 trip to Darien Lake, we departed for the park after school on a Friday and returned that evening. Feedback from students and chaperones reflected that going after school did not allow for a sufficient amount of time at the park. For the trip this year, the requested date is Tuesday June 20. Going on this date would allow for a full day trip. This date avoids conflicts with 8th grade classes and exams and allows for chaperone availability. We would leave the school at approximately 9:30, pending available bus transportation. We would arrive at the park at 10:30 when it opens. We would depart the park at 5:00, when the park closes for the day, to return to the school at 6:00 for students to be picked up by parents.
