To the members of the Wheatland Chili Board of Education:

On behalf of the Wheatland-Chili High School Band and Mixed Chorus, we are asking the Board of Education to approve an educational field trip for these groups to Boston, MA. The field trip would take place from Friday, April 26th, 2019 until Sunday, April 28th, 2019. Students would depart Scottsville at approximately 10:30 AM on Friday and return Sunday evening at approximately 9:30 PM. While in Boston, students would have the opportunity to take a guided tour of the historic sights of the city. The main priority of the trip, however, would be a music festival and competition.

There would be approximately 40-50 students in Band and Chorus attending the trip. Adults attending the trip would be Mr. Nicholas Roche, High School Vocal Teacher, Mr. Steven Zimmerman, High School Instrumental Teacher, and at least two other teacher chaperones.

Student payments would cover the cost of the trip including the cost of the four school chaperones. There will be at least one major fundraising opportunity, organized by the Wheatland-Chili Music Boosters, affording students the opportunity to individually and significantly cut the cost of the trip. The Wheatland Chili Music Boosters may also provide funding for additional items such as meals or an evening event. There is no cost to the district.
