TREASURER'S REPORT – The Board received the Treasurer's Report for January, 2016.

#### PRESENTATIONS/REPORTS/DISCUSSIONS

- a. <u>Elementary School Update</u> M. Wright gave an update on what has been occurring at the Elementary school. This included information on Project Lead the Way, literacy work, the Book Fair and bookmobile, the Mock Newbery Club, and curriculum work in social studies and math. The "T. J. Connor Reads" program begins next week.
- b. <u>Student Activities</u>: <u>Interscholastic Sports Update</u> S. Melville presented a brief overview of the interscholastic sports program. The winter season was reviewed and is coming to an end. Other information presented included athletic eligibility, coaching staff, sports offered, participation rates, Section V competition information, facilities and scheduling, and sports boosters. A breakdown of costs by sport and individual teams was shown, as well as items for future consideration.
- c. <u>Tax Levy Limit Calculation</u> B. Gillette presented the tax levy limit calculations for 2016-17.
- d. <u>Budget Development 2016-2017</u>: <u>Instruction (Elementary, Secondary, Sports, Co-curricular, Technology)</u> and <u>Employee Benefits</u> D. Leh presented the next and last portion of the budget. This consisted of an overview of instructional expenses related to elementary and secondary programming, sports, co-curricular, and technology, as well as employee benefits. A breakdown of related costs for these programs was presented and reviewed. Budget variables relating to expenses and revenues for 2016-17 were reviewed.
